As a Dental Assistant, you will assist dentists and dental hygienists during patient examinations and treatment procedures to ensure smooth workflow and patient comfort. Tasks typically include preparing and delivering dental X-rays, taking accurate dental impressions for diagnostic and restorative purposes, fabricating temporary crowns, and maintaining and sterilizing instruments and treatment areas in accordance with infection control protocols.

According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics*, overall employment of dental assistants is projected to grow 8% from 2023 to 2033, faster than the average for all occupations.
