As a Licensed Vocational Nurse (LVN), you will be part of a health care delivery team, providing basic nursing care, administering medications, health assessment, documenting a patient's signs and symptoms as well as carrying out therapeutic and rehabilitative measures. LVNs care for people who are sick injured, convalescent, or disabled under the support direction of physicians and registered nurses.

According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics\*, employment rates of licensed practical and licensed vocational nurses are projected to grow 5% from 2022 to 2032, faster than the average for all occupations.
